


1-June 19-23 “Aloha!”

Focus: Celebrating furry friends of all sorts:


Paddington, Winnie the Pooh, Corduroy, 3 Bears, Care Bears, etc. Use bear in your song books and art selection.

The Brothers Grimm and others fairy tale authors will help us explore a week of fairy tale based fun.




7- July 31 August 4 “Ocean Week”
